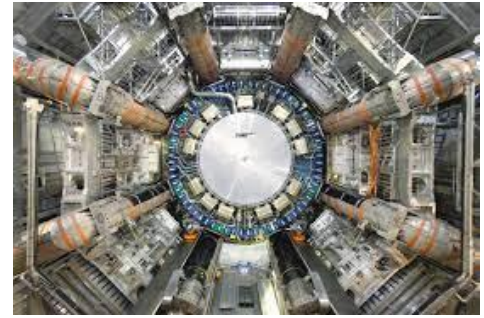

Accreditation in higher education is the most objective measure of the sustainability and international quality of education provided to students. At the same time, the certificates and diplomas of students who graduate from accredited programs are known and recognized internationally.

EUROPASS Diploma Supplement (Blue Diploma)

The "Europass Diploma Supplement", which was called the "Blue Diploma" by the Turkish National Agency until 2016, is a document given in addition to the diploma by higher education institutions that successfully implement the European Credit System (ECTS) and have the standards set by the



European Union Education Commission, and our university has gained the authority to issue the "Europass Diploma Supplement" since 2018 by meeting these criteria. This document aims to ensure a standardization throughout Europe of the achievements obtained in higher education, program details and grading system, information on the function of the diploma in terms of entry to further education and vocational aspects, and information on the national higher education system.

International Association of Universities (IAU)

Founded in 1950 under the auspices of UNESCO, IAU is a membership-based organization serving the global higher education community. The International Association of Universities (IAU) is an international NGO with official partner status of UNESCO, recognizing the key role that higher education plays in the process of achieving sustainable development. As a key source of expertise in the strategic priorities of Leadership, Internationalization, Sustainable Development, Digital Transformation, IAU provides consulting services and leadership programs in areas of expertise to increase the quality and access to higher education. Türkiye Qualification Framework (TYÇ) is a national qualification framework that determines all qualification principles acquired through vocational, general and academic education and training programs and other learning methods, including primary, secondary and higher education, designed to be compatible with the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).



Türkiye Qualification Framework is a classification tool in which diplomas, certificates and documents issued by the responsible institutions in Turkey (MEB, CoHE, MYK) are defined according to learning outcomes and those with quality assurance are placed in eight different levels.

The comprehensive structure that aims to include all quality assured qualifications in our country makes cooperation between the relevant institutions and organizations providing qualifications, the business world and social stakeholders indispensable, and this awareness is reflected in the management structure of the Framework as included in the Regulation on the Procedures and Principles Regarding the Implementation of the Türkiye Qualification Framework.

Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME)

PRME is a United Nations-backed initiative founded in 2007 that aims to raise the profile of sustainability through the Six Principles, which focus on serving society and protecting our planet. Working with six core principles, PRME aims to raise the profile of sustainability in universities around the world and provide future leaders with the knowledge and skills related to these principles. Our students contribute to the importance of societal and corporate sustainability, social responsibility and environmental protection.



TURQUALITY

TURQUALITY is the first and only state-supported branding program established to enable our companies, which hold the competitive advantage of our country and have product groups with branding potential, to become global players in international markets with their own brands by providing managerial knowledge, institutionalization and development covering all processes from production to marketing, sales to after-sales services, and to create and establish a positive Turkish goods image through these brands. The focus of the TURQUALITY Program is to contribute to the branding goals of companies instead of simply increasing exports, unlike classical export supports.

A joint project with UNESCO, WHED includes information on National higher education structure, Quality assurance systems, Governing bodies, Qualification information and admission criteria.



Higher Education Consortium

The Higher Education Consortium is a joint collaboration platform established by Cambridge University Press & Assessment for English language education programs of higher education institutions. The aim of this collaboration is to increase the efficiency of English language education programs in higher education, produce research-based solutions, share sample applications and produce joint research articles, and the academic process is carried out by the University of Cambridge.

Türkiye Barrier-Free Information Platform Partnership

The Türkiye Barrier-Free Information Platform has been working on information technologies and services for the disabled since 2011 with its Barrier-Free Information studies. The aim of the partnership is to carry out studies on the development, improvement and dissemination of Istinye University's information technologies and services for the disabled. Within the framework of the cooperation, the "IŞIK OL (BE THE LIGHT) EKPSS Course Project for the Visually Impaired" and "SES OL (BE THE VOICE) EKPSS Course Project for the Deaf" studies are carried out.
