SUSTAINABILITY AT ISU



While universities have the capacity to directly contribute to the society in which they are located through education, research, and social responsibility efforts, Istinye University, aware that it should also prioritize sustainability efforts as an institution, defines its Corporate Sustainability structure with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals as its fundamental principle. Together with all its internal and external stakeholders, it aims for integrated sustainable development based on economic, cultural, and governance principles, alongside environmental sustainability and social responsibility, as mentioned above, with the following principles:

- **Understandable** so that it can be embraced by all members of the ISU community at all levels.
- All existing efforts are appropriately **accessible** within the ISU Corporate Sustainability framework.

- Sustainability is **inclusive** of everyone within the institution and all activities, regardless of effort, content, or impact.
- Good and bad experiences are open to all higher education institutions in Turkey and other countries, so they can be **repeated**.

Bearing these principles in mind at all times, the objectives of ISU's Corporate Sustainability Structure can be summarized under four headings.

A Community Informed About Sustainability

The ISU Community comprises all students, faculty, administrative staff, and service providers operating on campus. It is envisioned that all groups within this community possess an understanding of the concept of sustainability. The Education, Research, Infrastructure and Operations, and Social Responsibility segments serve this purpose individually and collectively. The campus is essentially defined as a learning zone/testing ground. All learning techniques, including activity-based learning, passive learning, learning by doing, and others, can be tested. This understanding is also sought to be conveyed to the community in line with competencies.

Prosperity for All

Quality of life is one of the fundamental issues of ISU's Corporate Sustainability structure. While it holds such importance, it is also a goal that concerns the entire ISU community. Well-being for all encompasses not only the ISU community but also the entire ISU ecosystem. Happiness levels, awareness levels, and many other issues can be addressed.

Beyond the Legislation

Research and education, infrastructure and operations, and social responsibility sections are managed according to relevant Turkish legislation. However, the aim is to achieve better practice and to set an example that will be classified as voluntary and go beyond legislation. Efforts related to internationally recognized best practices are the definitive roadmap to achieving this goal.

All efforts to make universities sustainable should be a common priority for the ISU community. Here, initiatives should be supported in a guiding manner rather than being managed in an authoritarian way. This is the essence of the university: freedom of thought and action.

INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR SUSTAINABILITY APPLICATION AND RESEARCH

Istinye University collaborates directly with NGOs and national and international institutions within the framework of the Sustainable Development Goals. The International Sustainability Research Center (IRCOS) aims to conduct necessary research and applications that will enable progress at national and international levels through an interdisciplinary approach, and to develop recommendations regarding sustainable development policies and action plans.

In addition, Istinye University is an associated member of the European School of Sustainability Science and Research. Istinye University is also a member of the Jen Monnet Center of Excellence (ERASME). Istinye University has signed protocols with local governments (Zeytinburnu Municipality, Eyüp Municipality, Marmara Region Municipalities) to provide free education and health services and to conduct joint research on local issues.

Istinye University has numerous Erasmus and exchange agreements aimed at improving educational conditions.

ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIPS

In addition to Erasmus+ and international exchange programs, we aim to transform our university into a global and scientific educational institution through academic collaborations with leading universities around the world. In 2022, we signed general international cooperation agreements (MoUs) with 14 universities from 11 different countries and 55 bilateral Erasmus agreements with 22 universities from 13 different countries.

The Commission on English Language Program



Accreditation

CEA is a specialized accreditation body that accredits English language education programs. Its aim is a systematic approach where programs and institutions can demonstrate their compliance with accepted standards and continuously improve. In higher education, accreditation is the most objective measure of whether the education provided to students meets international quality standards and is sustainable. It also ensures that certificates and diplomas of students graduating from accredited programs are known and recognized internationally. Istinye University's Department of Foreign Languages English Preparatory Program was accredited by CEA in 2023.

European University Association (EUA)

EUA is an organization representing more than 850 universities in 49



European countries and plays a significant role in influencing the Bologna Process and European Union higher education, research, and innovation policies. International Cooperation and Integration, included in Istinye University's Strategic Plan, contributes to the university's development and increased competitiveness. Through this partnership, Istinye University facilitates cooperation and information exchange on higher education and research policies with 850 higher education institutions in 49 European countries.

EUROPASS Diploma Supplement (Blue Diploma)



The "Europass Diploma Supplement," formerly known as the "Blue Diploma" by the Turkish National Agency until 2016, is a document issued by higher education institutions that successfully implement the European Credit System (ECTS) and meet the standards set by the European Union Education Commission, in addition to the diploma. Our university has been authorized to issue the "Europass Diploma Supplement" since 2018 by meeting these criteria. This document aims to ensure a European-wide standardization of information regarding achievements in higher education, program details and grading systems, the function of the diploma in terms of entry into further education and professional development, and information related to the national higher education system.

International Association of Universities (IAU)



Founded in 1950 under the auspices of UNESCO, the IAU is a membership-focused organization serving the global higher education community. The International Association of Universities (IAU) is an international NGO with official partner status with UNESCO, recognizing the key role higher education plays in achieving sustainable development. With strategic priorities in Leadership, Internationalization, Sustainable Development, and Digital Transformation, the IAU is a key source of expertise and offers consultancy services and leadership programs in its areas of specialization to improve quality and access to higher education. It collaborates with numerous international organizations.

Observatory Magna Charta Universitatum



The Observatory is an association comprised of signatory universities that are independent of political organizations or interest groups. The signatory universities are linked to the institution through their rectors, presidents, and vice-rectors, who represent their institutions and are committed to adhering to the principles of the Magna Charta Universitatum, both now and in the future. Turkish Qualifications Framework (TQF)

The Turkish Qualifications Framework (TQF - TYÇ) is a national qualifications framework designed to be compatible with the European Qualifications Framework (EQF), defining all qualification principles acquired through vocational, general, and academic education and training programs, as well as other learning pathways, including primary, secondary, and higher education.



The Turkish Qualifications Framework is a classification tool in Turkey that defines diplomas, certificates, and documents issued by responsible institutions (Ministry of National Education, Council of Higher Education, Vocational Qualifications Authority) according to learning outcomes, and places those that have been quality-assured into eight different levels. This inclusive structure, aiming to encompass all quality-assured qualifications in our country, makes collaboration between relevant institutions and organizations providing qualifications, the business world, and social stakeholders indispensable. This awareness is reflected in the management structure of the Framework, as outlined in the Regulation on the Procedures and Principles for the Implementation of the Turkish Qualifications Framework.

Principles of Responsible Management Training (PRME)



PRME is a United Nations-supported initiative founded in 2007 that aims to raise the sustainability profile of universities around the world through its Six Principles, which focus on serving society and protecting our planet. Working with these six core principles, PRME aims to raise the sustainability profile of universities worldwide and to equip future leaders with the knowledge and skills related to these principles. Our students contribute to raising awareness of the importance of societal and corporate sustainability, social responsibility, and environmental protection.

TURQUALITY



TURQUALITY is the first and only state-supported branding program created to enable companies in Turkey that possess a competitive advantage and branding potential in product groups to become global players in international markets with their own brands. It achieves this by providing them with managerial expertise, institutionalization, and development across all processes from production to marketing, sales, and after-sales service, and by establishing and maintaining a positive image of Turkish products through these brands. Unlike traditional export support programs,

the TURQUALITY Program focuses on contributing to companies' branding goals rather than simply increasing exports.



World Higher Education Database (WHED)

The World Higher Education Database (WHED), providing reliable information on higher education systems, credentials, and institutions worldwide, is the IAU's online reference portal providing reliable information on higher education systems and credentials in 196 countries and territories, as well as on approximately 19,800 accredited higher education institutions. Continuously evolving to meet the needs of the global higher education community, WHED ensures the continuous collection, processing, verification, and publication of comprehensive and detailed higher education data on the portal. A joint project with UNESCO, WHED includes information on national higher education structures, quality assurance systems, governing bodies, qualifications information, and admission criteria.

Higher Education Consortium

The Higher Education Consortium is a collaborative platform created by Cambridge University Press & Assessment for English language teaching programs in higher education institutions. This collaboration aims to improve the effectiveness of English language teaching programs in higher education, generate research-based solutions, share best practices, and produce joint research papers, with the academic process managed by Cambridge University.

Türkiye Accessible Information Technology Platform Partnership

The Turkish Accessible Information Technology Platform has been working on accessible IT initiatives and information technology and services for people with disabilities since 2011. The aim of the partnership is to develop, improve, and disseminate information technologies and services for people with disabilities at IstinYE University. Within the framework of this collaboration, the "**Be a Light for the Visually Impaired EKPSS Course Project**" and the "**Be a Voice for the Deaf EKPSS Course Project**" are being implemented.

Partnership of the International Association for Cereal Science and Technology



The International Association for Cereal and Technology (ICC) is an international network of cereal scientists and technologists from around the world. As a leading international association in the field of cereal science and technology, the ICC aims to contribute to the dissemination of knowledge, research, and innovation, thereby improving food quality and safety. Since 2021, our university's faculty member, Prof. Dr. Hamit Köksel, has served as the President of the ICC.

Gas Detector Technologies Cooperation (DRD1)



DRD1 is one of the DRD (Detector Research and Development) collaborations established by CERN in 2023, in line with the Particle Detector Roadmap prepared by ECFA (European Committee for Future Accelerators) in 2021. DRD1 focuses on the development of gas detector technologies and aims to coordinate R&D studies in this field on an international scale. More than 160 institutions from over 30 countries participate in DRD1. Istinye University is the only private university among the three universities from Turkey that participated from the proposal stage onwards.

PATLIB

PATLIB (Patent Library) centers are regional information centers authorized by the European Patent Office to provide support in patent research and patent strategy. They are expected to provide consultancy in areas such as technology monitoring, patent

analysis, valuation, and commercialization. As of January 2024, following an evaluation process, Istinye University was selected from among 305 units and became one of the 54 PATLIB centers accredited by the European Patent Office.



TURKINIB

The Organization of Turkic States, comprising Türkiye, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, and Hungary, established the Union of Turkic Universities (TURKINIB) in 2013 to foster cooperation in higher education. Istinye University joined TURKINIB in 2024 as the 20th member from Türkiye.

Groningen Declaration Network (GDN)

The Groningen Declaration Network (GDN) is a global platform that brings together higher education institutions, governments, technology providers, and other stakeholders from over 40 countries worldwide to promote the portability of digital student data.

In line with the Digitalization and Internationalization goals included in Istinye University's Strategic Plan, collaborating with GDN enhances the university's global recognition and contributes to the digital transformation process in education. Istinye University is the first institution from Turkey to become a member of GDN.


